

Proposed Iowa Conference Bylaw Amendment

(Presented to the 2007 Annual Meeting to be voted upon by the 2008 Annual Meeting)

Article 1

Section 3. Voting Delegates, Numbers, Terms:

(a) Every member church in the associations recognized by this Conference shall be entitled to ~~one~~{TWO} voting delegate {S} (not including ministers as provided for in Section 2). Churches with memberships over ~~three hundred~~{one hundred} (300) {100} shall be entitled to another delegate for every additional ~~three hundred~~{one hundred} (300) {100}. {No church shall have more than six (6) lay delegates}. The delegates shall be elected or appointed as provided in the constitution and bylaws of the church they represent, and they shall hold office for one (1) year, or until their successors are elected.

Please note:

This is the proposed bylaw amendment as presented to the Annual Meeting in June, 2007. Per our rules of order, this is the language which will be put before the meeting in June, 2008. There is a good chance, however, that the Board of Directors will move an amendment to this proposal at that time. If that is to happen, the churches will be so notified in advance of the meeting.
